


Interesting Nursing Research

A recent study was done by a group of physicians for JAMA Psychiatry that suggests that the autism spectrum disorder prevalence may drop significantly following the production of the DSM-5. The DSM-5 has many notable differences from the DSM-IV, including more rigorous criteria for an autism diagnosis. Only 81% of children meeting the criteria for the DSM-IV diagnosis for autism met the criteria for the DSM-5 version. View the full article for more information.


